



Come & cycle your way around the outdoor commissions and open studios whilst exploring the Forth Valley. Celebrating the creative outdoors.

Inscriptions in Arcadia is a series of site-specific artworks situated in the beautiful and protected landscape around the Bothkennar Pools, near Skinflats. Visitors are invited to walk on easily accessible paths through this real landscape with its pine trees and lagoons, its reedbeds and fields, and imagine another - the semi-mythical land of Arcadia. You will encounter artworks created from found and made objects placed within elements of the land's rich industrial and cultural past. Each artwork highlights the unique historical environment of the area, transformed through inscriptions from classical mythology evoking the Gods, the Underworld and the pastoral. audreygrant.co.uk








The Allan Blikvangers are a series of Blikvanger-styled artworks created for a number of locations along the NCN 765 & 76 cycle routes between Stirling and Bridge of Allan. Inspired by the artists' own experience living in the Netherlands, the cycling capital of the world, the Blikvanger (bike path nets) comprising of large catching nets will collect cyclists' rubbish as they pass. A common sight in the Netherlands, they are a fantastic way to ensure cyclists dispose of their rubbish whilst they are on the move. Beautiful, sculptural forms in the own right, using recycled fishing nets they will be individually handmade, brightly coloured forms that add to the enjoyment of cycling. nataliemcilroy.com

The Trails are Calling (Canada Wood, Falkirk) are a series of artworks placed in the landscape of Canada Wood visualising these two artists/graphic designers, own love of the area which they frequently use and enjoy. The artworks provide an invitation to experience the beauty and nature of the surrounding woodlands. Each artwork comprises a colourful, bold, 4 sided hand painted wooden panel structure installed in a number of points creating a circular path to be experienced either on foot or by cycling. milkandtwoprint.com





the grass is getting long (artist-led cycle rides from Stirling Train Station) is an artist devised cycle route that draws upon the unique knowledge of local nature, the way we interact with landscape and the ephemeral experience of cycling. The title comes a conversation the artist recently had with a local keen cyclist 'by the way, the grass is getting long on the way to the peninsula.' The route will follow the River Forth taking in some of the local architecture and social history. The journey will go along existing paths and at times will also go off the beaten track, with each of the two events taking the route in an opposite direction.
